The Excellence in Science Department of Polish Academy of Sciences on December 17, 2018 is organizing a workshop for researchers planning to apply for grants from the European Research Council (ERC). The workshop will be held by Lotte Jaspers, a founding partner and CEO of Yellow Research in Amsterdam (https://www.yellowresearch.nl/).

Yellow Research is an European consultancy company, focusing on Horizon 2020 and in particular ERC grants. The company has an extensive experience in running EU workshops and in the presubmission proposal reviews. Workshop offered on the December 17 in Warsaw is <u>also</u> available commercially in Amsterdam (at the price of 625 euro per participant).

The purpose of the meeting is to provide potential ERC applicants with information on how to prepare a successful ERC proposal and manage the application process efficiently, increasing the chances of securing the grant. The workshop is addressed to researchers interested in submitting the ERC application in Starting and Consolidator calls in 2019 and 2020.

The workshops will be conducted in English. Participation to the workshop is free of charges.

Lotte has been advisor to the Dutch government with regard to Framework Programmes as well as the Dutch University Association (VSNU).
